H R A C NATIONAL'S

This being our first Nationals, I'm sure we will run into problems, but I hope no real major ones. If you feel that changes are in order, let me know! But I believe this way will work out ok.

First, the only class change for the Nationals is: Class #9 Showmanship, and you'll need to re mark all of your photo's to reflect this change. 9A will be for Stallions only, 9B for Mares only, 9C for Geldings only, 9D for Foals only. Being as this class is usually over 100, it will be more fair to all! REMEMBER, all horses in this class MUST have a halter on.

Bonnie will judge all classes per our regular classlist. She will not however be picking ANY of our usual monthly Championships, such as Stallion, Mare, Gelding etc. So, don't panic when you get your results back! Your horses will receive 3X normal points for their placings in this show.

The National Championships will be chosen by me, after I have tallied up the National results, along with the full year showing records of each horse! I'm up to date so far, so the results should be released before June 1st, our new showing season!

The following people will need to send me a LARGE envelope 6x9 minimum size please! Jeanette Mc Call, Trish Yanko, Kay Fowler, Jenny Provencher, Cheryl Green & Marcia Jones.

This envelope also will need postage, please send at least 4 or 5 stamps, excess will be returned if not used! This will be for return of your National Awards and results.

National awards of Commercial Rosettes will be issued to 16 Champions and 16 Reserve Champions! Plus, 140 Top Ten Commercial ribbons will also be awarded!! We will also be issuing ROM & LOM's to any horses that have qualified. And a Special award will be awarded to the Rarest H-R also!!!

The results of the National will be also listed in The Glass Menagerie of course.

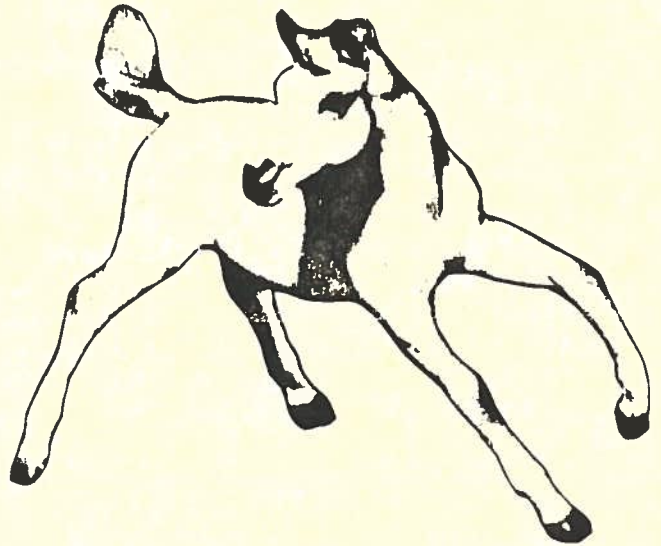
H-R # B-681 DRUM MAJOR

* All three of these Yearlings were designed by Maureen Love.



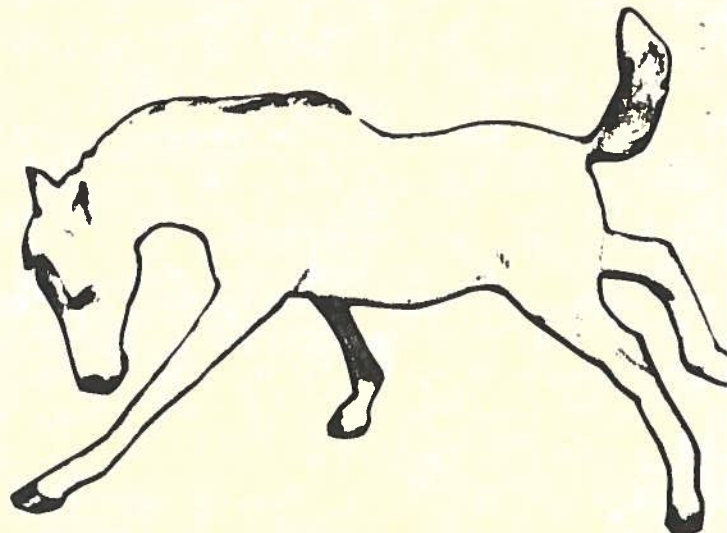
H-R # B-682 SKY CHIEF

This is the next one in this series, and he was made in white & palomino only. He was also produced from 1956 to 1959. He stands 4 3/4" at ear tips.



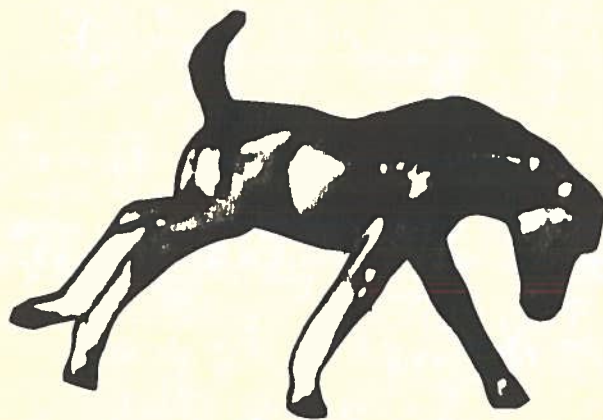
H-R # B-680 MISCHIEF

This is the last Yearling of this series. He was made in palomino & White only, and was also produced from 1956 to 1959. He is only 2 1/2" at ear tips, due to his head being lowered so far!



H-R # A-361 YEAPLING

These are the 3 Yearlings that look almost like the DW's!! This one was produced from 1958 to 1959 only. He came in bay, brown & buckskin,, both in matt and glossy finishes. He is only 1" at ear tips, due to his head being lowered so far!
